For Females and Males

No blue or colored jeans/jeggings allowed.

Students in grades K-5 may wear shorts; students in grades 6-8 may NOT wear shorts. All Grade levels are to adhere to the uniform policy.

Students are expected to keep themselves well-groomed and neatly dressed at all times. Any form of dress or hairstyle which is considered contrary to good hygiene or which is distracting or disruptive in appearance and detrimental to the purpose or conduct of the school will not be permitted.

Students are not permitted to wear outer clothing of any kind during school. Hats are not permitted to be worn in school under any circumstance or hoodies. V-neck or button-down sweaters are allowed. *At the inconvenience of the parent uniform violations will be addressed.*

Open-toe shoes, sandals, slippers, or flip flops are not permitted. Students must wear appropriate, comfortable shoes.

Uniform Rule Infractions:

1st: Parents are notified by phone to acquire uniform.

2nd: Detention and/or suspension
