**NUMBER OF COVID CASES CONTINUE TO DECLINE IN NEW JERSEY**

New Jersey's total number of COVID-19 cases is 882,973 and 23,313 COVID-19 fatalities. As of Friday, there were 954 residents hospitalized, with 224 of these individuals requiring intensive care and 157 on ventilators. Saint Peter's COVID census is currently at 14, with only two COVID patients in the intensive care unit and no ventilators in use. The state's rate of transmission is 0.66.

There are 3,683,166 fully vaccinated New Jersey residents, accounting for 7,987,479 doses of the vaccine administered in New Jersey. It is estimated that another 165,254 residents have been fully vaccinated through out-of-state vaccine programs.
