

NEW BRUNSWICK HEALTH SCIENCES TECHNOLOGY HIGH SCHOOL ADMISSIONS FAQ

Which students can apply?

- Any New Brunswick resident in the 8th grade
- Any New Brunswick resident in the 9th or 10th grade with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or above with the required coursework completed
- The 8th grade child of a full-time employee of Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital
- The 9th or 10th grade child, with a G.P.A. of 3.0 or above of a full time employee of Robert Wood Johnson University Hospital

When does the application process begin?

The application process begins each November. The application and timeline are posted on the school website, are mailed to district, charter, and parochial schools, and are available in the school office.

When is the Open House?

An Open House is held each December and offers the community the opportunity to meet students and staff, to learn about the course offerings, and to tour the school. The date and time of the Open House are reflected in the application timeline and are posted on the school website.

Is there an Entrance Assessment?

Yes. The entrance assessment is administered to all applicants. The purpose of the assessment is to provide applicants with the opportunity to interact with coursework similar to that which they will encounter in the ninth grade year.

The assessment has four (4) components: Mathematics (equals 35% of the total weighted test score); Grammar/Reading (equals 20% of the total weighted test score); Science (equals 35% of the total weighted test score) and, a writing sample (equals 10% of the total weighted test score). Students are not allowed to utilize a calculator during the assessment. The writing section is scored by certified English teaching staff using a rubric with scores ranging from 1-5.

Students applying to the 10th or 11th grade also participate in the entrance assessment. Their scores are prorated to the average scores of those applying for 9th grade placement.

How many students are accepted each year?

Offers of admission are made to approximately 62 incoming 9th grade students in order to have a freshman class of 57 - 58 students. This allows for families that may move, decide to have their child attend another school, or refuse the offer of admission for other reasons.

Students are accepted into the 10th or 11th grade depending upon available seats and whether the students have taken prerequisite courses, such as Biology and Spanish I.

How is the decision made to accept a student?

A number of factors are considered in making the decision to offer admission to an applicant.

These factors include:

Report Card Grades

Performance on the Assessment

Letter(s) of reference

Standardized Test Scores

Attendance Record

Student Application Essay

Each of these items has a point value that is entered onto a spreadsheet resulting in a total score. The 62 students with the highest total scores seeking placement in the 9th grade are offered admission.

These factors, as well as the GPA and prerequisite coursework, are considered for students applying to the 10th or 11th grade.

I missed the timeline. Can I still apply?

Yes. All applications will be accepted, however action may or may not be taken on the application depending upon a number of factors. The availability of a seat in the requested grade level is the primary determinant.

PREGUNTAS FRECUENTES PARA

¿Qué estudiantes pueden postularse?

- Cualquier residente de New Brunswick en octavo grado
- Cualquier residente de New Brunswick en el noveno o décimo grado con un G.P.A. de 3.0 o superior con las clases requeridas
- El hijo / hija de octavo grado de un empleado a tiempo completo del Hospital Universitario Robert Wood Johnson
- El hijo / hija de noveno o décimo grado, con un G.P.A. de 3.0 o superior, de un empleado a tiempo completo del Hospital Robert Wood Johnson University

¿Cuándo comienza el proceso de solicitud?

El proceso de solicitud comienza cada noviembre. La solicitud y el calendario se publican en el sitio web de la escuela; se envían por correo a escuelas distritales, autónomas y parroquiales; y están disponibles en la oficina de la escuela.

¿Cuándo estará la casa abierta? Cada mes de diciembre se celebra una Casa Abierta que ofrece a la comunidad la oportunidad de conocer a estudiantes y personal, aprender sobre las ofertas de cursos y recorrer la escuela. La fecha y hora de la Casa Abierta se reflejan en la línea de tiempo de la solicitud y se publican en el sitio web de la escuela.

¿Hay una evaluación de entrada?

Si. La evaluación de ingreso se administra a todos los solicitantes. El propósito de la evaluación es brindar a los solicitantes la oportunidad de interactuar con cursos similares a los que encontrarán en el noveno grado.

La evaluación tiene cuatro (4) componentes: Matemáticas (equivale al 35% del puntaje de la prueba ponderada total); Gramática / Lectura (equivale al 20% del puntaje total ponderado de la prueba); Ciencia (equivale al 35% de la puntuación ponderada total de la prueba) y una muestra de escritura (equivale al 10% de la puntuación ponderada total de la prueba). Los estudiantes no pueden utilizar una calculadora durante la evaluación. La sección de escritura es calificada por personal docente de inglés certificado utilizando una rúbrica con puntajes que van del 1 al 5.

Los estudiantes que solicitan ingreso a los grados 10 u 11 también participan en la evaluación de ingreso. Sus puntajes se prorratan a los puntajes promedio de los que solicitan la colocación en el noveno grado.

¿Cuántos estudiantes son aceptados cada año?

Se hacen ofertas de admisión a aproximadamente 62 estudiantes entrantes de noveno grado para tener una clase de primer año de 57 a 58 estudiantes. Esto permite a las familias que pueden mudarse, decidir que sus hijos asistan a otra escuela o rechazar la oferta de admisión por otros motivos.

Los estudiantes son aceptados en los grados 10 u 11 dependiendo de los cupos disponibles y si los estudiantes han tomado cursos de prerrequisito, como Biología y Español I.

¿Cómo se toma la decisión de aceptar a un estudiante?

Se toman en cuenta varios factores al tomar la decisión de ofrecer la admisión a un solicitante. Estos factores incluyen: Calificaciones de exámenes estandarizados Rendimiento en el registro de asistencia de evaluación Carta (s) de referencia Ensayo de solicitud del estudiante

Cada uno de estos elementos tiene un valor en puntos que se ingresa en una hoja de cálculo, lo que resulta en una puntuación total. Los 62 estudiantes con los puntajes totales más altos que buscan colocación en el noveno grado reciben admisión. Estos factores, así como el GPA y el trabajo previo del curso, se consideran para los estudiantes que solicitan el 10 u 11 grado

Me perdí la línea de tiempo. ¿Aún puedo solicitar?

Si. Se aceptarán todas las solicitudes, sin embargo, se pueden o no tomar medidas en la solicitud dependiendo de una serie de factores. La disponibilidad de un asiento en el nivel de grado solicitado es el determinante principal.
